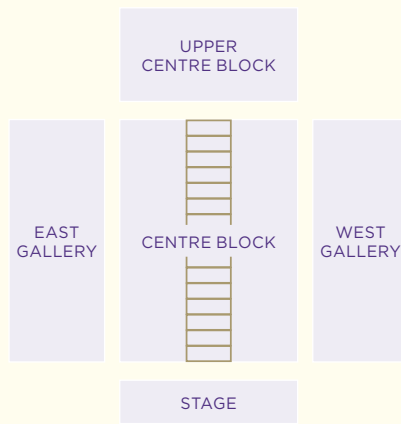


Theatre Seating Plan

PIANO RECITAL

7.30PM WEDNESDAY MAY 2ND 2012

Having had our largest audience for the year at Martin's concert in 2011 and being amazed by his contribution to the Ribble Valley International Piano Week held in the Theatre in July, we are greatly looking forward to hearing him again. With more than 500 broadcasts and 7 Prom appearances, his CDs always receive great critical acclaim, though he can still communicate with a young audience as shown by his masterclass at Westholme last year and his Professorship at London's Guildhall School of Music. His website diary shows him performing throughout Britain and the world, including a visit to Munich to perform Gershwin's Piano Concerto in March. He plans to include Beethoven's Pathetique Piano Sonata in this concert plus Schubert's Sonata in B Flat D.960 and Debussy's Arabesque No.1, Children's Corner Suite and L'isle joyeuse. This concert is presented in association with the Ribble Valley International Piano Week and tickets will be unreserved with doors opening at 7pm. The school orchestra will play from 7.15pm. (*Concessions only apply to students for this concert.)
