FUN AT THE FARM



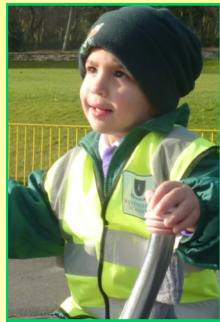
