SIXTH FORM UNIFORM

Appearance

The Sixth Form have their own uniform guidelines and on occasions are asked to wear their formal uniform (see list for specific details). It is designed to be more flexible but smart. We also expect the Sixth Form to be neat and tidy. Hair, make-up and accessories should be appropriate for the workplace.

If a member of staff thinks that a Sixth Former's appearance is not appropriate they will speak to them about their concerns and may ask them to come to school in formal uniform for one week.

UNIFORM LIST

Uniform is designed to be smart but comfortable and to give a little flexibility. It should be seen as something suitable to wear for the 'office', i.e. be acceptable in the work place.

Formal Uniform:

- School blazer
- White shirt
- School tie
- Black skirt (knee length, fitted on the waist)
- Black/natural tights
- Suitable black shoes that are safe and comfortable.
Heels should not be more than 3cm and stiletto heels are NOT allowed.

Every day Uniform

- Black skirt (knee length, fitted on the waist)
- Plain white coloured shirt/blouse with sleeves
- Plain black sweater (round or v neck)/cardigan/tank top.
This is to be worn over the shirt/blouse, not on its own.
- Black/natural tights
- Suitable black shoes (please see above)

Please note:

Coats must be plain grey or black fabric (no leather or denim).
A school scarf or a plain scarf in any school colour may be worn outside in winter months only.

The following items are NOT allowed:

Bare shoulders/midribs
Sweatshirt tops
Tops with patterns/logos
Denim
T-shirts or polo shirts

Jewellery, make-up and accessories should be discreet.
