



## WESTHOLME SCHOOL

### THE WESTHOLME ASSOCIATION RECREATION CENTRE

The Recreation Centre Committee was formed as a sub-committee of the executive Committee to build the Swimming Pool and to organise the use of the sports facilities for members.

#### **MEMBERSHIP:**

##### **Membership of the Recreation Centre is restricted to:**

- Members of the Westholme Association
- Children of members who are themselves not old enough to be members of the Westholme Association
- Spouses of former pupils who are eligible for membership of the Westholme Association

There are two classes of membership: **Annual Members** and **Ten Year Members**.

#### **APPLICATION:**

Application for membership must be made on the prescribed application form which can be obtained from the School Office. The membership year is from 1<sup>st</sup> September to the following 31<sup>st</sup> August.

#### **COMMITTEE:**

The Recreation Centre is managed by the Recreation Centre Sub-committee. Two thirds of the members of the Committee must be Life Members of the Recreation Centre.

#### **ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP:**

- The membership year is from 1<sup>st</sup> September to the following 31<sup>st</sup> August. Applications for membership after 30<sup>th</sup> April will be charged at the rate of £8 per month).

#### **TEN YEAR MEMBERSHIP:**

- A number of new Ten Year Members are admitted each year at the discretion of the Committee.
- There are sessions in the Swimming Pool and Sports Hall reserved for Ten Year Members only.
- Children cannot be admitted to Ten Year Membership unless at least one parent is also a Ten Year Member.
- The fee may be paid in two equal instalments – the first with the application form and the balance not more than six months after the application.

#### **GUESTS:**

Members may introduce guests who can enjoy the facilities of the centre on payment of a guest fee. No guests are allowed on Life Member and Ten Year Member only sessions.

## **GENERAL**

### **SWIMMING**

- Will parents please note that no life saving attendant is provided, so the safety of their children is the parents' responsibility and neither Westholme School nor the Association can accept responsibility for any accidents that occur.
- The use of lilos and balls is prohibited
- Members with long hair are requested to wear bathing caps

### **BADMINTON**

- Gym shoes must be worn in the sports hall

### **TENNIS**

- Members are expected to play in whites
- Gym shoes must be worn both on the outdoor courts and in the sports hall
- The indoor tennis court should be booked in advance by contacting the Chairman of the Tennis Section (*see details in Hall*).

### **ATTENDANCE SHEET**

Members are asked to sign their names and guests names on the attendance sheet.

### **MEMBERS FEES**

No extra charge for use of Swimming or Outdoor Tennis. However, to help towards the cost of heating and lighting the Games Hall members will be charged a court fee.

### **MEMBERSHIP CARDS**

To avoid the misuse of the facilities by non-members, supervisors are asked to check cards, so Membership Cards must be carried at all times as proof of membership.

## **COURT FEES**

### **Indoor Tennis:**

£4 per court per hour for singles or doubles.

50p per person per session.

**Swimming:** £1.00 per schoolchild, £1.50 per adult (under school age – free of charge)

**Outdoor Tennis:** £1.00 per schoolchild, £1.50 per adult

**Indoor Tennis:** £2.00 per person in addition to court charge

**Badminton:** £1.00 per person
