Entrance Examination/Assessment Fee - Juniors & Seniors	£45
Registration Fee	£50
• Deposit (Pre School to Sixth Form) - On accepting a place an initial deposit of £300 is required. £150 of this deposit will be deducted from the first term's fees leaving £150 to be held as security which will be refunded on leaving subject to all conditions being met. Should you not take up the place the deposit will not be refunded.	£300
• Deposit (Nursery) - A deposit of £450 is required to reserve a place. Upon entering Reception class, £300 will be deducted from the first term's fees leaving £150 balance as above.	£450

The preferred means of payment is by Direct Debit which will be requested five working days after the start of term. New parents are requested to complete and return a mandate form six weeks prior to the start of term.
