Brief career history	After qualifying as a teacher in 1997 I started my teaching career at St Pauls' RC Primary School, Feniscowles where I taught in the Reception class for 5 years. I moved to Westholme in September 2002 and taught in the Reception class here until I left full time teaching in July 2005 to marry and start my own family. I continued to work at Westholme in a part time capacity as well as undertaking some supply work in various schools within Lancashire and Blackburn with Darwen. I gradually increased my hours back to full time at Westholme in September 2012. I have been lucky enough to work closely with all of the teachers at Westholme Infants and have enjoyed teaching in all of the year groups here. In September 2012 I was appointed full time Year 1 teacher and became Deputy Head of Westholme Infant School and Early Years Leader in September 2014. I am thrilled to be part of the leadership team leading the Nursery and Infant school and work very closely with Mrs Barnett to ensure a seamless transition throughout all of the primary phase.
What attracted you to Westholme?	Growing up locally, I already knew about Westholme's superb reputation and when the opportunity arose for me to apply for a teaching post here I jumped at the chance!
