SCHOOLBLAZER

The Westholme uniform is available to buy on www.schoolblazer.com.

The SchoolBlazer website is easy to use; simply register yourself and your child/children and the site will direct you to the uniform required for your child/children.

Full school uniform should be worn at all times; this includes official school games kit which should not be worn at any time other than for sports based activities. Hoodies do not form part of the school uniform.

OUR UNIFORM

At Westholme, our school uniform reflects a sense of identity and pride, throughout the younger years boys feature green tones and purple tones for girls . As students enter the Sixth Form, the dress code becomes more flexible, encouraging greater independence. They are expected to wear formal business attire, preparing them for the professional standards they will encounter beyond school.

SIXTH FORM (YEAR 12 & 13)

DRESS CODE

Sixth Form students should be regarded as role models for students lower down the school, and their standards of dress are an important part of the culture of the Sixth Form.

The aim of the dress code is to have a smart appearance that allows a degree of personal choice and encourages students to understand what is appropriate; school is a workplace and students' appearance should reflect that. They are expected to come to school in 'formal business dress' as they would for the workplace.



SUITS

Students are expected to wear a smart suit that has a formal jacket with trousers, a skirt or a dress. Suits should be black, navy or grey. Alternatively, they may wear a smart jacket/blazer with coordinating skirt, dress or trousers. No clothing may be made from denim, leather, PVC or similar alternatives.

JACKETS

A smart jacket/blazer must be worn when moving around the school building (exceptions may be made in the summer months) rather than carried. It is not acceptable to wear a short coat in lieu of a jacket.

SKIRTS/DRESSES

Skirts and dresses must be worn to the knee. They should be tailored and not lycra or 'bodycon' style. It should not be possible to see through the material of the skirt. If students do not have a skirt to the required length, they should wear trousers as per the information below.

TROUSERS

Trousers should be smart suit-style trousers. Chinos are permissible, so long as they are accompanied with an appropriate blazer/jacket. Jeans, leggings, combat trousers, and cords are not allowed. Hipsters and low-slung trousers should not be worn and the midriff should not be exposed.

TOPS/BLOUSES/SHIRTS

Skirts or trousers should be worn with a shirt top or blouse which covers the shoulders, upper arms and midriff. It is not acceptable to wear a t-shirt, polo shirt or vest top. Tops should not be low-cut, off the shoulder or see-through. Shirts must be fastened to the top button with a tie and should be tucked into trousers at all times.

SIXTH FORM (YEAR 12 & 13)



TIES

Male students are expected to wear an appropriate tie at all times.

SWEATERS & CARDIGANS

A plain light-knit V-neck long-sleeve sweater, 1/4 zip (non-sporty) or cardigan may be worn under the jacket, as may a co-ordinating waistcoat.

Sweaters should not have large, branded logos or designs, and should be in the neutral colours of black, navy or grey.

Hoodies and chunky knit garments are not allowed.

COATS

A smart tailored coat may be worn to and from school, but should not be worn around the school premises when indoors.

SHOES

Shoes must be appropriately smart, practical and sensible. Trainers, UGG boots or canvas shoes must not be worn, unless taking part in relevant activities. Ankle boots may be worn with trousers.

FORMAL DRESS

On several occasions throughout the school year, Sixth Form students will be expected to wear Formal Dress. For such occasions they should wear a dark-coloured suit with a white shirt or blouse or a dress. Students will be told in advance when formal dress is to be worn.

SPORTS KIT

It is preferential for students continuing into the Sixth Form to continue to wear their school sports kit for both training and fixtures. For new students joining the Sixth Form, the school sports kit is available to purchase via Schoolblazer.

In the Sixth Form, plain sports kit in neutral colours is permissible, with students allowed to wear non-branded items in black, navy, white or grey. Brightly coloured kit is not permitted.

Westholme sports hoodies are permissible for training only, not fixtures, unless directed otherwise by a member of the PE staff. When representing the school in sport, students must wear school sports kit, which will be provided for football, hockey and netball. Girls should wear black sports leggings.

Boots and muddy shoes must not be worn indoors at any time. Branded shirts, professional football or other sporting merchandise must not be worn. Sports kit must only be worn at the time of a practice or PE lesson; students should change in and out of their kit at the time of the event and must not arrive at school in sports kit for an entire day unless permission has been granted.

Students requiring sports kit for enrichment should change at the time of the lesson and not beforehand.

SIXTH FORM (YEAR 12 & 13)



OTHER GUIDANCE

- Sixth Form students are permitted to wear jewellery but are asked to keep it minimal and discreet.
- Students should not have any visible piercings (other than earrings) or tattoos.
- Clothing that is too revealing or likely to cause embarrassment must be avoided.
- Students' hair should be well-kept, clean and moderate in style, length, colour and treatment.
- No clothing with obscene slogans or messages is permitted.
- Headscarves for religious observance may be worn in the Sixth Form: they should be plain and dark coloured.
- Students are also reminded that the wearing of hoodies, scarves and outdoor coats in school (especially to lessons) is not allowed.
- Make-up and nail varnish may be worn but should be discreet.
- When students are wearing a dress or skirt they should wear tights and not socks. Bare legs should also be avoided.
- Trimmed beards and moustaches are allowed as long as they are smart and tidy.

The above list is not meant to be exhaustive but instead represents a guideline to the meaning of 'business dress'. Because of the constant changes of fashion that take place, it has to remain the right of senior staff, Sixth Form Tutors and the Head of Sixth Form to determine that a particular item of dress is not appropriate for School.

Students who turn up to school inappropriately dressed will be reprimanded by staff and persistent offenders will be asked to go home and change. If students persist in failing to follow the guidelines stated, further discussions will take place.

Please note that the same dress code applies when students sit external examinations.



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
